
Brief Note of Visit of Delegates from Nepal

Delegation from Nepal comprising 23 participants including Senior Govt. Officials, Project Coordinator on their study tour to Parvati Watershed Division Kullu arrived on 1.03.2015. On 2-3-2015 delegates were taken to field visit in GP Kais and GP Gahar. Divisional Watershed Development Officer welcomed the delegates in GP Kais and briefed about the project activities being undertaken under Mid Himalaya Project in Parvati Watershed Division. In the field Members of delegation interacted with members of Vegetable seedling group Ghanshayam, Asha Kiran group of Vermi compost in Village Seobag of GP Kais and CIG Vyas Handloom group in village Seobag in GP Gahar. Members were taken to nursery, Vermi compost pit, handlooms. They enquired about the criteria for selection of beneficiaries and activity under livelihood component and the impact of project activities in the enhancement of income.

In the a/n Delegate members were taken to CIG Vyas Dashami Varda at village Malahar. This User Group has constructed a RCC tank with a cost of Rs.125658/-. Tank has provided irrigation for 2 Ha. agricultural land, which was rain fed previously. Due to this the group members have now started growing high value crops instead of traditional crops, thus getting more income.

At last the delegation met Knitting group Devi Dashami varda at village Kais. This group are making woolen socks ,Sweaters ,baby sest etc. which were displayed to members. The group members are now earning on the average Rs. 1500 to Rs.2500 per month from this activity.
